

Fixed Anchor Permit Application Instructions:

All applications must be filled out completely and accurately.

When available, accurate, up to date maps will be provided with application submission. All applications will be submitted by mail or e-mail to:

Applications submitted to the Jones County Conservation Board Office will not be processed.

Applications will be reviewed on a bi-annual basis by the Climbing Advisory Committee for recommendation to the Jones County Conservation Board for approval.

Upon approval/rejection you will be notified by mail with a copy of your application and the appropriate signatures.

While conducting work related to the application submitted, you must keep a copy of the approved application on your person at all times.

WARNING AND LIABILITY DISCLAIMER: Rock climbing is an inherently dangerous activity. All persons are strongly urged to seek competent instruction and develop appropriate skill before climbing on their own. Jones County does not certify climbers, instructors or guides, or otherwise determine their qualifications.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

The individual or organization signing a FIXED ANCHOR PERMIT acknowledges and represents that she/he/it wishes to participate in rock climbing Pictured Rocks Park. Rock climbing in Pictured Rocks Park is not an organized activity of Jones County and should not be considered an official Jones County event or activity. Those signing a FIXED ANCHOR PERMIT further acknowledge and understand that any "instructor" or "organizer" of any rock climbing classes or activities are not acting within the scope of any employment relationship with Jones County. Those signing a FIXED ANCHOR PERMIT acknowledge, represent and agree that she/he/it assumes all risks, if any, attendant to participating in rock climbing at Pictured Rocks Park. They hereby knowingly, voluntarily and intelligently waive all claims for injury in rock climbing.

Note: Jones County is not liable if a climber gets hurt or killed while climbing in Pictured Rocks Park. If climbers choose to climb, they do so at their own risk!
